Ms. Bouclé is the Executive Director for the Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO). Since joining the agency in 2016, she has been leading the charge, along with the Miami-Dade TPO Governing Board, to provide mobility choices for the residents of Miami-Dade County through the local transportation planning process, and more specifically the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit “SMART” Plan.
