Class Location The classes will take place in a secure Broward County Government building in Plantation with ample parking. Please allow time to go through security.

Class Description

This class is designed to refresh participants' awareness-level skill set for hazardous materials emergency situations. Attendees will receive training to comply with HAZWOPER Refresher requirements as specified in 29CFR1910.120 including HAZWOPER fundamentals, chemical exposures, hazard assessment, fire and explosion, flammable materials, oxygen deficiency, heat stress, radiation contamination, mercury spill guidance, air monitoring, respiratory protection and PPEs (Biological Agents/Ebola), drums and containers and others. Students will receive copies of the 2016 ERG book.

Target Audience

Public works, public health, utilities, fire, law enforcement, transportation, sanitation, water and sewer, environmental personnel and others likely to witness, discover or be the first person on scene of an emergency involving hazardous materials.
