Class Description

This course will address the various components & systems of the MC306/406 Gasoline Tanker, the most common Haz-Mat transport vehicle in the nation. Discussion items will include the chemical properties associated with the most common transported commodities (Gasoline & Diesel fuels) and an overview of the tanker's various safety features as well as a review of various incidents. A Gasoline Tanker Truck will be on site as part of the class (if available). Following the course, emergency responders will have a better understanding and working knowledge of the tanker features in the event of a leak, spill, rollover or fire situation.

Continuing Education Units (CEU)

This class is approved for four Florida Fire Inspector or Instructor CEUs (**Course #ATPC12926**).
