Subject: Broward County Comprehensive Plan Amendment 19-T1: Transmittal for Expedited State Review

Dear Mr. Eubanks:

On March 28, 2019, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners adopted the BrowardNEXT2.0 Comprehensive Plan. Following adoption, the BrowardNEXT2.0 Comprehensive Plan was submitted to the Broward County Planning Council (BCPC) for recertification. The BCPC found several deficiencies and issued a Provisional Recertification Report in June 2019. The proposed amendments are intended to achieve consistency with the Broward County countywide Land Use Plan (BCLUP) and Florida House Bill 7103.

The Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department's Local Planning Agency held its public hearing on August 23, 2019. The Broward County Board of County Commissioners held its transmittal public hearing on December 3, 2019. These amendments are being transmitted to your agency for expedited state review. On December 12, 2019, complete digital copies of the amendment package, including supporting data and analysis, were sent to the state review agencies listed below for expedited state review.

Broward County expects to adopt the proposed amendments in March 2020. The proposed amendments are not related to an area of critical state concern designated pursuant to Section 380.05, Florida Statutes.
