2:05 – 3:05 **Livable Transit Corridors: Methods, Metrics, and Strategies - Bruce Appleyard and Chris Ferrell, CFA Consultants (60 minutes)**

Dr. Jurado will share parallels to the TOD Working Group and lessons learned.
