Pursuant to Chapter 163.3191, Florida Statutes, please find attached the City of Sunrise transmittal package for an adopted Land Use Plan Amendment to the City of Sunrise Future Land Use Map (FLUM). The transmittal package includes two (2) electronic copies on compact disc and one (1) hard copy. The City of Sunrise Commission held duly advertised public hearings on November 14, 2017 and September 26, 2018, adopting Ordinance No. 385-18-A. Please find enclosed one (1) original and two (2) copies (on CD-ROM) of Ordinance No. 385-18-A, which adopts the amendment changing the land use from Commercial (C) to Irregular (19.2 DU/AC) Residential for the 15.15-acre subject property. In addition, a detailed future land use map of the amendment area is provided.

The amendment was transmitted by the Board of County Commissioners along with a corresponding amendment to the Broward County Land Use Plan on April 24, 2018, under the expedited State review process (DEO #18-3ESR). The amendment report reflects no changes in the data and analysis from the transmittal submission package.
