Subject: Adopted Expedited Application No. CDMP20180014 to Amend Miami-Dade County Comprehensive Development Master Plan (CDMP), for Miami-Dade County, Florida – SLPA Amendment No. 18-15ESR

Dear Ray:

On January 24, 2019, the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopted Ordinance No. No.19-7, taking final action on Expedited Application No. CDMP20180014 to amend the CDMP. This application was filed by the Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources as a standard text application and processed through the County's expedited CDMP amendment review process. I am authorized by Section 2-116.1(4) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to make this transmittal of the adopted standard amendment in accordance with Section 163.3187(1), Florida Statutes (F.S.) on behalf of the Board.

The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity/State Land Planning Agency (SLPA) and other state and regional agencies (reviewing agencies) previously reviewed the pending application as contained in the amendment package, which was previously transmitted to the reviewing agencies by letter dated October 12, 2018. The South Florida Water Management District (SFWMD) offered recommendations for revising the application by correspondence dated November 16, 2018, and the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) offered technical comments in a letter dated November 20, 2018. The Miami-Dade County Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources addressed said comments of the SFWMD and the FDOT by letters dated December 11, 2018 and December 12, 2018 included herein in Exhibit 4, respectively. Except for the aforementioned technical comments, no objection was raised against the application by the SLPA, the reviewing agencies, or any affected party; nor were there any changes to the application which were not previously considered by the Board.

Enclosed herein and made a part of this letter is a "List of Supporting Documents Submitted to the Reviewing Agencies for the Miami-Dade County Adopted Expedited Amendment No. CDMP20180014" (see Attachment A). The list identifies all documents that are required in Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes.
