Approx. 33% retained and 66% pass-thru





- SoFlaLEPC is one of ten LEPC districts in Florida
- Includes Miami-Dade, Broward, and Monroe Counties
- Work closely with Palm Beach
   County in areas related to Regional
   Domestic Security
- Created by the State Legislature in 1988 to implement EPCRA in Florida







- Next meeting August 21 at SFRPC and open to the public
- Currently 48 members, including:
  - Miami-Dade, Broward, Monroe and Miramar Emergency Mgmt
  - MD DERM & WASD, Broward Env & Consumer Protection Div
  - Miami-Dade, Miami, Ft Lauderdale & Marathon Fire Rescue
  - FDOH; FDEP; FDOT
  - Borden Dairy, Miami VA, Memorial Healthcare, Federal Bureau of Prisons, Florida Gas Transmission, Sentry Industries, Allied Universal and many other private sector partners





- Not a Response Agency but rather a Resource Provider:
  - Points of Contact from Fire Departments, HazMat Teams, County, Municipal and State Agencies
  - HazMat Facility Information
    - Locations, rep names, chemicals, quantities
  - Provide Free HazMat Training
  - Presentations and Public Outreach
  - Conduct Training Exercises







## **Conduct Hazards Analyses in Monroe County**

- Under EPCRA regulations, hazards analyses are required on HazMat Facilities every other year
- Facility site visit (not inspection) may be required
- Verify Address and Emergency Contacts
- EHS\* chemicals, amounts and largest container
- Determine <u>probable affected</u> area and population in the event of a chemical release

<sup>\*</sup> Extremely Hazardous Substances





## Plan and Conduct Training Exercises, including:

- 2008 HazMat event from truck accident
- 2010 Radiation leak at a construction site
- 2012 Chemical spill along US27
- 2014 Rail-related HazMat incidents at 3 locations
- 2016 LNG Transport Incident
- 2018 Anhydrous Ammonia incident during transport
- 2019 CSX Rail HazMat Incident







## June 19, 2019 CSX Rail HazMat Incident Training Exercise

 60 participants from 26 State, County and Municipal Departments and Agencies and private sector partners







- Offer <u>FREE</u> hazardous materials training to responders and others in the public/private sector
- Over the last 17 years have provided more than 5,000 students nearly 73,000 hours of training






# South Florida RPC Activities related to the SERDSTF



- The Southeast Regional Domestic Security Task Force (SERDSTF) is one of seven in Florida
- Members include LE, FR, EM, environmental, hospitals, education
   & private sector
- Boundaries coincide with those of FDLE, FDOH, FDEM
  - Miami-Dade, Broward, Monroe and Palm Beach Counties





# South Florida RPC Activities related to the SERDSTF



- Receive grant funds from the DHS Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) and State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP)
  - Act as Fiscal Agents for 8-10 Regional Information Analysts
  - Housed at MDPD, BSO and PBSO working for the Southeast Florida Fusion Center
- SFRPC assists the Region in planning, coordinating and conducting training exercises
