In August of 2020 the SFRPC was awarded the EDA CARES Act Supplemental grant to enable the Council to help the region to prepare for, prevent, and respond to existing and future impacts by expanding its economic development COVID-response activities including technical assistance, and enhancing regional planning, collaboration, and intergovernmental coordination among local governments, economic development organizations, the business community, and other key stakeholders.



Financial Assistance ~ During a Pandemic

The U.S. Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration is partnering with the South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC) to oversee and administer a new \$5.9 million CARES ACT Business Revolving Loan Fund program that will alleviate sudden and severe economic dislocation caused by the coronavirus in Monroe, Miami-Dade, Broward, and Palm Beach counties. Designated a U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development District in 1994, the SFRPC welcomes this new program into its lending portfolio as it continues to expand its economic development activities.

2021 Regional Legislative Priorities

The South Florida and Treasure Coast Regional Planning Councils, represented by elected and appointed officials from Monroe, Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, and Indian River counties, in Joint Session identified the following regional issue priorities. **We ask that you please incorporate these priorities into your state and federal action agendas:**

Resolution TCSF #20-01 ~ Florida's Coral Reef

• Support the establishment of a long-term, recurring revenue source for Coral Reef disease intervention and restoration at both state and federal levels;

- Support the federal legislation "<u>Restoring Resilient Reefs</u> <u>Act of 2021</u>" (<u>S. 46 / HR 160</u>) to restore and conserve America's Coral Reef;
- Support state legislation <u>SB 588</u> (Senator Book) / <u>HB 217</u> (Rep. Hunschofsky): <u>Conservation Area</u> <u>Designations/Kristin Jacobs Coral Reef Ecosystem</u> <u>Conservation Area</u>
- Urge the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission to work collaboratively to develop and implement as soon as possible a long-term coral reef conservation strategy for the Southeast Florida Coral Reef Ecosystem Conservation Area.
