## 6. Subcommittee Reports

# <u>Training Subcommittee</u> (Jason McMahon)

- The LEPC sponsored an 8-hr. OSHA HAZWOPER Refresher training for Miami Dade's Water and Sewer Department. Over 300 employees were trained, and these courses wrapped up in late May.
- Broward HazMat Response Teams including Broward Sheriff's Office FR, Sunrise FR, Hollywood FR, and
  FTL FR completed a 160-hr. Hazardous Materials training course for new special ops firefighters. This
  training also wrapped up in late May.
- OSHA HAZWOPER Refresher training for Miami-Dade's Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources starts the first week of August.
- The LEPC sponsored a small group of students from MDFR and Broward EM to attend a CAMEO software training.
- There is still HMEP funds available for public agencies and departments in need of hazardous materials-related training. A list of approved training courses is available upon request. Courses must take place before September 30, 2021.

## Planning Subcommittee (Jason McMahon)

- 2021 South Florida LEPC Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Plan was approved by the Chair on June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Available for interested members and parties.
- Members for this year's Planning Subcommittee will be requested to join towards the end of the year.

#### Exercise Subcommittee (Jason McMahon)

- The Exercise Subcommittee held an MSEL/Exercise Design Meeting on April 8<sup>th</sup>. Following this meeting, the Final Planning Conference was held on May 6<sup>th</sup>.
- The LEPC held a functional exercise on May 27<sup>th</sup>. This exercise was centered around a radiological event
  and included participants from Broward and Miami-Dade HazMat response teams, as well as Memorial
  Healthcare. The FDOH's Bureau of Radiation Control (BRC) played a key role by providing "hot" radioactive
  samples.
- The LEPC is looking to begin planning the next exercise starting in November.
- Looking to increase involvement across the region with higher participation from more facilities, healthcare agencies, and regional response agencies.
