### 6. Subcommittee Reports

**Training Subcommittee** (Jason McMahon)

- The LEPC sponsored an 8-hr. OSHA HAZWOPER Refresher training for Miami Dade's Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources that wrapped up in August. Approximately 90 students participated in the training.
- The LEPC sponsored a 4-hr. CAMEO Suite Software training course that took place throughout the month of August.
- Broward County HazMat Teams participated an LEPC-sponsored 8-hr. Air Monitoring and Detection training course. This course was completed in late September.
- Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) Grant funding for FY2021-2022 has been approved. The HMEP Contract started on October 1<sup>st</sup>.
- The LEPC is gearing up to send teams to the 2022 HazMat Symposium that takes place in January. Registration is open for the Symposium.
- Offshore HazMat training course set to be offered during this fiscal year. The LEPC plans to train a team at both the Port of Miami and Port Everglades.
