# Department Overview

- Fully integrated waste management system that provides collection, transfer and disposal services
- Largest publicly operated solid waste collection and disposal system in the southeastern United States
- Provides waste collection services to more than 340,000 households in a 320-square-mile waste collection service area
- Disposal system processes approximately 1.8 million tons of waste annually
- Countywide mosquito control services include mosquito trap monitoring, and treatment




# Services We Provide

### North Dade Landfill



- 215 Acres
- Class III Landfill
- Accepts trash material such as old furniture, yard trash and construction and demolition debris
- Two cells; West Cell Closed, East Cell is Active
- Serves the Northern Region of the County and accepts about 250,000 tons per year
- Estimate of reaching capacity by 2026

### South Dade Landfill



- 300 Acres
- Class I Landfill
- Accepts a variety of waste, including garbage, and trash
- Five cells; three cells have already been filled and closed; fourth is filled and in the process of closing
- Fifth cell is the active cell; landfill accepts 550,000 tons per year
- Estimate of reaching capacity by 2032




