# **Roles for South Florida LEPC?**

- Pursuant to the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act, a Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) is responsible for preparing a regional hazardous materials emergency response plan, serves as a repository for regional hazardous materials information, and performs outreach functions to increase hazardous materials awareness.
- Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC) are <u>NOT</u> response agencies
- LEPCs provide a forum for chemical-related emergency planners, responders, and stakeholders
- The Region 11 LEPC (as well as FL's other LEPCs) use the forum to share resources and coordinate
- LEPCs serve as a Point of Contact (POC) for Fire Departments / Hazardous Materials teams, intergovernmental agencies (e.g., Local, County, State), and chemical-storage facilities
- Force Multiplier: 35+ members from different sectors ready to assist!

# **Roles for South Florida LEPC?**

- Chemical storage information: Via E-Plan, LEPC's can access Section 302 facilities' Tier II reports and risk management data (e.g., chemicals on site, quantities, points-of-contact)
- Coordinate <u>free</u> HazMat-related training within the region (more details later)
- Upon request, provide technical assistance to the region for EPCRA-related items (e.g., conducting hazard analyses, Tier 2 reporting)
- Conduct presentations and outreach: like this one! 🗑

Chapter 2. EPCRA Section 302: Emergency Planning Notification

The purpose of EPCRA Section 302 is to establish and identify a list of substances of concern and gather information on the presence of these substances at each facility in the community for emergency planning and response. Specifically, this section of the law requires EPA to publish a list of extremely hazardous substances (EHSs) and their threshold planning quantities (TPQs) and requires facilities that handle these substances to notify their SERC or TERC and LEPC or TEPC that the facilities are subject to emergency planning.

# Why are **LEPC's** in every region of the state?

.EP

- The Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act (EPCRA) was passed by Congress in 1986 as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA Title III)
- EPCRA was created to protect communities from the health and environmental hazards associated with hazardous chemicals in the US.
- Under Section 312 of the Act, regulated industries must file an annual Tier II report with the SERC and local fire department for hazardous and/or extremely hazardous substances stored, used, or manufactured on site for more than a 24-hour period at any time during the previous calendar year.
- LEPCs in Florida were created by the State legislature in 1988 to implement EPCRA



# What is the make up the LEPC?

- Current membership consists of local professionals representing occupational categories such as fire rescue / HazMat, law enforcement, emergency management, environmental, transportation, public utilities, health / medical, and private industry. For example:
  - Miami-Dade, Broward, Monroe and Miramar EM Dept's
  - FDOH, FDEP, and FDOT
  - Fire Rescue: Miami-Dade, Monroe, City of Miami, FTL, Hollywood, and more
  - Broward Enviro & Consumer Protection, Miami-Dade Enviro Resource Management, and Miami-Dade Water & Sewer Dept
  - Borden Dairy, Memorial Healthcare, Florida Gas Transmission, Cliff Berry, Jet Blue, Dean Foods/McArthur Dairy, Gordon Food Services, and more

# **\*\*Other Duties as Assigned\*\***

- Annually, LEPCs update the HazMat Emergency Response Plan. The Plan closely follows Counties' Comprehensive Emergency Management Plans (CEMP)
- Conduct annual training exercises to test and validate the Plan
- LEPC holds quarterly meetings that are open to the public
- Next meeting: <u>February 15, 2023 (Virtual)</u>









# South Florida LEPC Exercises

- Training Exercises from the last several years
  - 2018 Anhydrous Ammonia incident during transport
  - 2019 CSX Rail HazMat Incident
  - 2021 Functional Radiological Exercise: Completed with the assistance of FDOH's Bureau of Radiation Control; Brought "live" radioactive samples to multiple locations is Broward and Miami-Dade to test responder's HazMat devices
  - 2022 Propane (Autogas) flare off

- Over the last 19 years, we have provided more than 6,000 students nearly 74,000 hours of training

# How is E-Plan information verified?

- Under EPCRA regulations, counties are required to conduct hazards analyses on Section 302 Facilities
- Counties may contract with LEPCs to conduct the analyses for them
- The South Florida LEPC is contracted to conduct analyses for Monroe County
- Miami-Dade and Broward counties independently conduct their own analyses

# What is a Hazard Analysis?

- For each Section 302 Facility that reports to the State, counties must identify or verify the following:
  - Location
  - Emergency Contacts
  - Transportation routes to and from the Facility
  - EHS chemicals, amounts, largest container
  - Determination of probable affected area and population in the event of a chemical release





# What is a Hazard Analysis?

- Facility site visits, not inspections, will take place to verify information
- Information is reported into CAMEO (Computer-Aided Management of Emergency Operations)
  - MarPlot Mapping application (EPA)
  - CAMEO Information management software (EPA)
  - ALOHA Plume modeling software (EPA)
  - CAMEO Chemicals Online chemicals database (EPA)

#### Welcome to E-Plan's Online Tier II Reporting System

This easy E-Plan online reporting system will allow you to create a report you can submit to your state to meet their requirement for filing of (SARA Title III) Tier II Emergency and Hazardous Chemical Inventory Reports. This system is for Tier II filing organizations to file their Tier II reports to the State each year. However, filing Tier II report via E-Plan may not fulfill the mandate per your state SERC and/or county LEPC and local fire department. Contact your State and County officials to see if they accept E-Plan as a form of electronic filing.

#### **Important Notes**

- 1. Completed Tier II forms for reporting year 2017 are due by March 1, 2018.
