Prerequisites:

Each of these courses are each stand alone. The single pre-requisite for any of the courses is the IS-2200, Basic EOC Functions.

Course Description:

The Emergency Management Institute (EMI) is offering Emergency Operations Center Skillset courses.

These courses assist individuals and jurisdictions who desire to develop or improve their Emergency Operation Centers (EOC). By the end of the course, students will be able to demonstrate, through activities and a Final Exam, the skillset roles of the modern-day EOC. Courses focus on actions and products produced in an EOC before, during, and after an event.

Course Customization:

These courses are designed to be fully customizable for Local Courses (designated as "L") and State/Tribal sponsored courses (designated "G"). Those partners should edit the course materials including exercises, activities, slides, and examples to better align with local policies, constructs and procedures.

Training the Trainers:

There is no stand-alone "Train-the-Trainer" course for the Skillset series. Yet, FEMA and EMI are dedicated to the idea that States and our Tribal Partners maintain their ability to efficiently train their own staff through G and L-Courses. Therefore, considerations will be made for local trainers to obtain seats in the virtual courses above. If requested, those local trainers will be given the opportunity to teach units depending on their availability. Contact the POC below for more information.
